

**Dr Phil Boyle** Graduated in Medicine from the National University of Ireland, Galway in 1992. He was the first doctor to bring Natural Procreative Technology (NaProTechnology®) treatment to Ireland and Europe.

NaProTechnology is a new Reproductive Science, developed by Consultant Obstetrician Dr. Thomas Hilgers in Omaha, Nebraska, USA . It is disease based approach to managing infertility and miscarriage consistent with Catholic medical ethics.



Dr. Boyle is a General Practitioner with a special interest in Infertility and Women's Health. He has treated over 3,000 sub fertile couples since 1998. He presently runs a busy practice in the Galway Clinic. Many of his patients have had successful pregnancies despite long term infertility, recurrent miscarriages or previously failed attempts at In Vitro Fertilisation (IVF).

The data from Dr. Boyle's practice was analysed and published in the **Journal of the American board of family Medicine (JABFM) in Sept 2008**.
